EOLWA promotes advance planning and envisions a day when all Washington residents will make informed decisions so they may experience peaceful deaths consistent with their values.

Dr. Connie Brumm is a retired family physician who volunteers with End of Life Washington, serving both as a client advisor, and as a speaker, on end of life topics. She will speak on ways that terminal patients can choose to hasten their death in a dignified manner and discuss the recent changes to Washington's Death With Dignity Law.
